I. Shade selection

- · Shade guide
- Before the tooth has been prepared
- Be moistened and held to close to the tooth
- · Be checked in good light
- Be noted on the patient's chart and laboratory prescription
- · Infection control

II. Preparation

- · Retention aids for crowns
- Core buildup
- Pin retention
- · Post and core
- Shade selection

III. Impressions

- · Gingival retraction and tissue management
- · Gingival retraction cord
- Epinephrine/aluminum chloride
- · Cord packing instrument
- Final impression (master impression) and bite registration

IV. Placement of provisional coverage

- Purposes of provisional coverage(temporary coverage)
- Reduce sensitivity and discomfort in the prepared tooth
- · Maintain the function and esthetics of the tooth
- Protect the margins of the preparation
- · Prevent shifting of adjacent or opposing teeth

V. Retention aids for crown

- Core buildup: self-curing or light curing composite material, reinforced glass ionomer cement, amalgam restoration
- Pin retention: add strength to the core build-up
- Post and core : endodontic treatment tooth, provide strength and stablility

VI. Gingival retraction and tissue management

- · Gingival retraction
- · Gingival retraction cord
- Epinephrine/aluminum chloride(mineral astringent)
- · Cord packing instrument
- · Chemical retraction
- Surgical retraction (Electrosurgery): hypertrophied tissue
- Mechanical retraction: modified provisional crown(extends into the sulcus)
